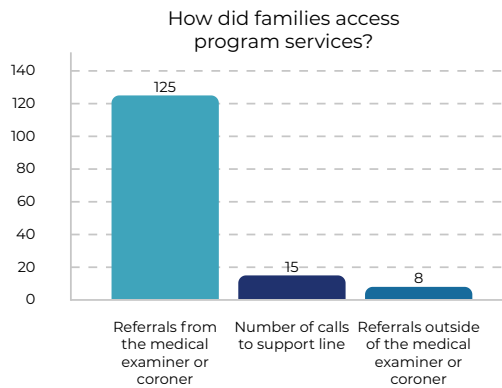

Drowning: 1

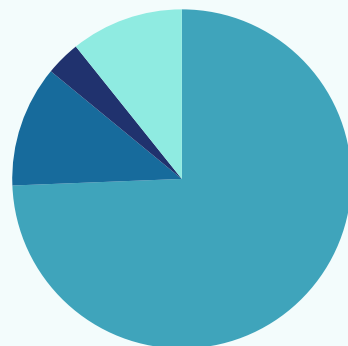
